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

Dear MiTek family,

It's me, Tham Nguyen and my Global ID is 708267. In the Team Leader presentation, I presented the topic about Gender Equity. I shared my experience with sexism in my family during my childhood, which was the tradition of Vietnamese people where women and thought to be weaker than men.

I was really surprised that my story is added into the content of May Newsletter.

Come on, let's go back to my childhood with my story.

Growing up in my hometown, every family considered that having sons was more important than having daughters. Everyone wanted at least 2 or 3 sons. Because they thought that sons would take care of them when they got old, but daughters, couldn't help them with anything. My father had the same thought, when my mother gave birth to her first baby, it was a girl, my father was not happy about that, but because this was the first one, so he accepted. Then the second one was my sister, a girl again, he started to get upset. And the third one is me, he was really upset. From that time my father always put pressure on my mother, and forced her to give birth until he had at least 2 sons. There were already 3 kids in the house, we didn't have enough food to eat but he didn't care. He only cared about how to have sons.

I remembered very clearly that when I was about 12 years old, when I saw my dad taking out his rage on my mother when she said that she didn't want to have more children. I shouted at him that I could do whatever the boys could do. And on that day, I had my



hair cut, very short, just like a boy's hair. After that I started to learn how to do the farmer's work, such as plowing the field by cow, carry rice straw home by bicycle or carry rice from the field home by shoulder...

You can see, a girl around 12 years old could do hard tasks and that a girl can be strong! We all can see there are more and more female managers/ team leaders being promoted in this company, right? This clearly proves that women are not inferior to men.

Women are so amazing! Don't lose your confidence because of Gender Equity. Believe in yourself! Do whatever you want to do, just keep going forward then we will get more than ever expected.

The last thing I want to share with you is that I have the recognition from my father, who ill-treated his wife and his daughters. Before passing away, the last sentence he left for me was, I am very lucky to have you! My feelings burst out after more than 20 years of striving.


