



### #Junehabit:

### HOW TO REMEMBER VOCABULARY WORDS LONG TERM?

As a language learner, you work hard to expand your vocabulary. You plough through new words every day, make long lists of words and practise with flashcards. However, when it comes to speaking, the new words seem to fall out of your head, so you resort to your old friends – words you already know and have used many times – again and again. Remembering and using new words in speech is often a challenge for language learners. Here are some strategies to help you make words stick in your mind and use them in conversation.

### • Learn in chunks and scripts

We retain words better when we learn them in small 'chunks' (i.e. small phrases that combine several words) and 'scripts' (i.e. typical dialogues). For example, instead of memorising the phrasal verb 'to come up with', memorise it as part of the phrase 'to come up with an idea'.

### Visualise what the word or phrase looks like

Drawing what the word means, either on paper or in your imagination, will help you recall the meaning of the word whenever you hear it.
This method works well with idioms, such as 'to keep one's mouth shut'
(informal), meaning, 'to not talk about something'.

\* **Tip:** In addition to the image of the word, look at word associations in the visual dictionary and thesaurus Visuwords

#### Create mnemonics

Try to create a funny phrase or story that will strengthen the connection between the word and its meaning (known as a mnemonic). I find this technique especially effective when I need to recall words that are hard to spell.

\*Here are a few mnemonics created by my students:

'career' – car and beer 'island' – is land 'to lose' – uh-oh, I've lost an 'o'



\* Tip: There are a lot of mnemonics available online, such as the 'mems' created by users in Memrise, but you will have a better chance of remembering the word if you invent your own.
